From Pastor Karla

Dear Sister and Brothers in Christ,

By the time you read this I will be on holiday (aka vacation ©). I want to take a moment to thank you all for ALL the support you have shown me these past months. I really am having fun being with you all, but I cannot do what I do without you doing ALL that you DO, so thank you!!!

And with that, I will be with you, as your interim, for longer than any of us had anticipated. I was with Bishop Jones and Assistant to the Bishop, Pastor Brackett last week and they had no pastoral candidates to present to Lord of Life at this time and they have no one on the horizon. So, your church council and I discussed at our last meeting that we, as a community, must move forward and plan...and be pleasantly surprised when the Call Community can start interviewing. Keep praying for pastoral candidates and their discernment and may the Holy Spirit lead them in the direction of Lord of Life.

Moving forward and planning -

As you have read in previous newsletters and I have mentioned, at the end of April, I went to Grandview University for "Faith Forward" training (funded by the Christian Parenting and Caregiving Initiative of the Lilly Endowment Inc. housed at Grand View University, and works in collaboration with Peer Ministry.

Faith Forward has a three-fold aim:

- 1. **EMPOWER** rural and small congregations (that's us!!!) to more effectively work with parents, grandparents, and faith mentors through the normal routines of congregational life to help them hand down their Christian faith and values to the next generation.
- 2. **EQUIP** parents and grandparents with doable, repeatable, livable faith practices.
- 3. **ENCOURAGE** parents and grandparents in creating homegrown faith through easy-to-use activities and resources which weave faith formation into the normal routines of family life.

This will be ADDING to/ENHANCING what we have already been doing with our Intergenerational Faith Formation over the last few years.

You ALL will be getting invitations to workshops (led by the "Faith Forward" trainers) for parent, grandparents and mentors (meaning....there is a training for EVERYONE !!!)

With all of that in mind, I realized this 'idea' or 'theme' needs to be implemented in ALL that we do at Lord of Life Lutheran Church. With your church council's permission, our theme, starting in the Fall, will be something like: "Lord of Life MOVING Faith Forward" (Bri Ensign is already working on a combined logo!)

I have already been brainstorming with folks to create "pop-up" teams for this next academic year (I know, school isn't even out yet as I am writing this.....but we gotta plan and look forward!!!). The teams I have thought of so far are:

1. Worship 2. Education 3. Activities 4. Hospitality 5. Prayer 6. What else ??? 😊

I know this might sound boring on paper....but it really will not be.....I promise !!!! I ask you to start prayerfully considering what team you would like to be on....and be ready for me to ask you!

On Pentecost Sunday, I ended my sermon with this:

"You love Jesus, but do you trust him? Do we trust God's Holy Spirit to inspire us... 'to set us on fire, transform our lives, turn the world upside down'...do we trust God's Holy Spirit to move and motivate our individual hearts and then our community heart, here at Lord of Life? If the answer is yes, then we can no longer put umbrellas up when the Holy Spirit is moving. And I am going to be reminding you of this fact this summer – yep, I, along with the council and a few other folks, are already planning for the fall – and we are going to need for you ALL to trust the Holy Spirit and need you to be 'all in' when our programming starts in the fall."

Can you tell I am excited? I truly am! The Holy Spirit is moving at Lord of Life as we come closer as a community of faith, so that we can pass our faith on to our younger ones and to new members that will come into our midst. My prayer is that we be open to the Holy Spirit, let us not rush to put up umbrellas, but instead, let us hold up our open hands and say, "God, where do you need me?"
